FUNDRAISER FOR BACK KITCHEN

Dear Members,

We need your help. For many years, the Owatonna Eagle's Club has been very fortunate to have the talents of Jim Karsten keeping the equipment in our back kitchen operating smoothly. Jim has worked diligently to repair and maintain various pieces of equipment down at the Eagle's Club; however he is no longer able to locate parts to repair items that are essential to our everyday operations.

What items, you ask? We are in urgent need of replacing the two convection ovens and the 4-burner gas stove in the back kitchen, as well as the glass washer in the front bar. 1942A

- The **upper convection oven** is non-functioning, is non-fixable, is over 30 years old, and parts are no longer available for needed or future repairs.
- The **lower convection oven** is currently functional, but is over 30 years old, and parts are no longer available for needed or future repairs.
- The **4-burner gas stove** is over 40 years old, is obsolete, and parts are no longer available for needed or future repairs.
- The **front bar glass washer** is also obsolete and in need of replacement.

Estimated costs to replace the equipment:

\$ 8,000 for the two convection ovens (1 unit)
\$ 2,000 for the 4-burner gas stove
\$ 3,000 for the glass washer
\$13,000 TOTAL

We are asking our members to help us raise the funds needed to replace this equipment. **Any donation would be greatly appreciated!** If each member donated \$15 toward the replacement of the equipment, we would reach our goal of \$13,000. Donations may be mailed to the Club in care of Aerie Secretary Ron Ankrum or dropped off at the Eagle's Club with the bartenders for Ron Ankrum. Please make sure you indicate that your donation is for the back kitchen equipment.

We would like to extend a **very heartfelt THANK YOU to Eagle's Member Don Turek** who has graciously donated the first \$500 to the fundraiser for the back kitchen equipment.
