We fire up the outdoor grill and food is available for

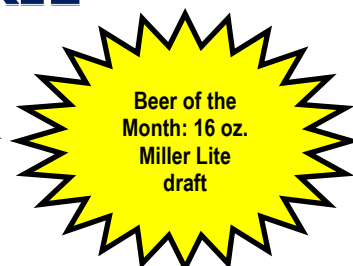
