The 53rd Annual Owatonna Eagles Cancer Auction fundraiser will take place at the Club on Friday, February 6, and Saturday, February 7, 2015.

Join us for this two-day event as we all come together to raise money and awareness for cancer research. The two-day event features live auctions of new donated items, gift cards or certificates, gift baskets, and merchandise. All proceeds from the two-day event stay in Minnesota for cancer research and benefit the Mayo Clinic, the University of Minnesota, and the Hormel Institute.

The 2013 Cancer Auction raised \$25,500 and the 2014 Cancer Auction raised \$34,041.

Donated items will be auctioned off live on Friday, February 6, beginning at 6:30 p.m. and Saturday, February 7, beginning at 4:00 p.m.
